There are three one-hour poster session blocks, all scheduled on Wednesday, July 7. You are asked to be present on Zoom (link to be provided) throughout your entire hour session.

- Session 1: 09:00 EDT (New York)/15:00 CEDT (Rome)/ 21:00 CST (Shanghai)
- Session 2: 13:00 EDT (New York)/19:00 CEDT (Rome)/ 01:00 CST (Shanghai, next day, July 8)
- Session 3: 19:00 EDT (New York)/02:00 CEDT (Rome, next day, July 7)/ 07:00 CST (Shanghai, next day, July 8)

Please let us know no later than May 17 if you cannot make your assigned slot and if you would like to switch one of the other two poster session times.

Registration should be open by the end of the week at <https://networks2021.net/registration> and will be announced online and through email. All presenting authors should register by June 1 to maintain their spot. If you are waiting for news of student fee remission, please do not put off registering - you may either pay (and be refunded) or you can choose to pay by invoice, which will allow you to finish payment (or for us to apply fee waivers) later.

We will open the Whova conference platform to registered participants starting June 14. In Whova, you will have the ability to correct errors in your title or abstract and upload a pdf of your slides.

As mentioned in the acceptance email, we ask that you prerecord a 2-3 minute teaser video for your poster by June 28 at 9 am EDT. We will send a notice with detailed instructions on how to upload your video in early June. Judging for the poster award will rely on receiving these videos in a timely manner, but in addition, we plan to use the videos to help promote attendance at the poster sessions.

We anticipate a few more direct emails to presenting authors before the conference starts.
