Please check the tentative oral contribution speaker schedule listed here (<http://bit.ly/H8jfhglwuvn>) or the poster list here (<https://bit.ly/3nOuTYT>), organized by OpenConfID. You will see a session assignment, date, and time block of your talk. If you are available during that block, no further action (other than registering for the conference) is needed at this time other than to mark it in your calendar!

Over 700 of our 970 authors let us know about scheduling conflicts (or the lack of), and we have tried to accommodate those restrictions while still maintaining as many organized sessions and thematic general sessions. We are certain there are errors and missing information, so we want to give you a final opportunity to let us know if this schedule DOES NOT work for you. The deadline to do this is May 17 at 8 pm EDT. Please fill out this form (<https://bit.ly/3f65Mg4>).

If you submitted to an organized session and do not find your talk assigned to that session, this was either due to a scheduling conflict or because the organizer asked to keep the sessions smaller.

You will notice your time block is three hours long. We will work as quickly as possible after the response form closes on May 17 to reassign speakers and then send an exact and final time slot (15 mins for oral contributions) within their assigned sessions.

Registration is now open and available at <https://networks2021.net/registration>. We ask that all presenting authors register by June 1 at the latest to maintain their spot. If you are waiting for news of student fee remission (link available on the registration page), please do not put off registering - you may either pay (and be refunded) or you can choose pay later or by invoice.

We will open the Whova conference platform to registered participants by no later than June 14. In Whova, you will have the ability to correct errors in your title or abstract, and upload a pdf or image, should you wish to do so. At this point the OpenConf system is closed to further edits.

We anticipate a few more direct emails to presenting authors before the conference starts, particularly about the procedure for uploading prerecorded talks. If you are concerned about receiving emails, you may always check our website at <http://networks2021.net/correspondence> to see an archive of any mass mailings we are doing to authors about their sessions. We will be starting a newsletter with announcements as well.
